



Implementing Dry Mixed Recycling (DMR)

As part of our commitment to reduce our environmental impact and improve our environmental performance, we have introduced “Dry mixed recycling” within the business. Two new “Dry Mixed” wheelie bins have been added to our waste area and three internal recycling containers added to selected offices. These bins are to be filled with recyclable materials.

As we improve our recycling, we intend to add more internal recycling waste bins throughout the offices thus helping to further reduce our environmental impact. Eventually this means that we will reduce our general waste and increase recycling within the business.

Items currently being recycled are:

- **Paper** - e.g. dry paper waste, newspapers, office paper and magazines
- **Cardboard** – e.g. corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes and card
- **Metal cans** – e.g. clean, empty drinks cans and food tins

As we get better at recycling we will look at reducing our carbon footprint in further areas such as reducing our energy levels by introducing “Energy Drives” that encourage people to switch off unused appliances, purchasing energy efficient equipment and looking at other ways that we can make Sharp a cleaner and better business.
